The college has submitted the Part I information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. MARBH has examined the profile of the College as to whether the college fulfills the Minimum Standard Requirement to be fulfilled as per the prevailing regulations under Clause 28 of NCH Act 2020.

On Careful Examination of the Application, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has Observed the following Shortfalls as per the MSR requirement:

a) Miscellaneous

- Form 16 of all staff is not legible; copy of Form 16 of all the faculties may be submitted for verification.
- College has not enabled the Adhaar Enabled Biometric Attendance System (AEBAS). The same may be implemented within one month of time.

b) Hospital Details

- Case records should be well maintained With Demographic Details of the Patient Such Name Age, Sex, Proper Address And Phone Numbers etc And Follow-up Attendance Of The Patient with complete case history, analysis, evaluation and repertorization and made available in Medical Record Room for academic purpose of students and follow up attendance of patients.
- Diagnosis should be written in ICD 11 criteria.

Considering the above observation and facilities available, MA&RBH has decided to issue conditional permission to Dr. G.D. Pol Foundation Yerala Homoeopathic Medical College and Research Centre, Institutional Area, Sector - 04, opp. Khargar Railway Station, Khargar, Navi Mumbai- 410210, Maharashtra for conducting BHMS course with student intake of 100 seats in BHMS course and 24 seats for P.G course in 05 PG subjects namely, Organon, Materia Medica, Repertory with 06 seats each and Practice of Medicine and Pediatrics with 03 seats each for the academic year 2024-25.

All admissions shall be made from NEET /AIAPGET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 BHMS course and 24 P.G Seats shall be treated as All India Quota. Counseling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by respective Counseling Authority of State /UT. The permission of the College stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid directions of the Central Govt/NCH for All India quota or the student admitted there under.

The College wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET/AIAPGET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.


Permission to the college can be withdrawn or denied in subsequent year if the college found deficient in compliance to MSR 2013 any time during the academic year.

As per the observations made by MARBI, following shortfalls are noticed for immediate rectification:

Teaching Faculty-

For PG: Associate Professor in Dept. of Organon, Materia Medica and Repertory are not available.

College is required to follow standard guidelines in the functionality as under-

- Case records should be well maintained in respect of case analysis, evaluation and reportization and made available in Medical Record Room for academic purpose of students and follow up attendance of patients.
- Case sheets should have complete demographic details and contact details of patients.
- Diagnosis should be written in ICD 11 criteria

Therefore, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy has decided to issue conditional permission to Dr. G.D. Pol Foundations Yerala Homoeopathic Medical College and Research Centre, Institutional Area, Sector - 04, Opp. Khargar Railway Station, Khargar, Navi Mumbai - 410210, Maharashtra for conducting BHMS course with student

Any admissions carried out other than NEET/AIAPGET qualified students will not be approved by Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

A. Teaching Faculty:

- College has provided the combined list of full time teachers, separate list of faculties for Undergraduate and Postgraduate course is required for verification.
- Previous experience of Guest Faculties in Department of Organon of Medicine, Department of Materia Medica, Department of Pharmacy, Department of Forensic Medicine and Toxicology, Department of Practice of Medicine, Department of Surgery, Department of Obstetrics & Gynecology and Department of Repertory are not provided. Moreover, Dr. Omkar Mate, Guest Professor, Department of Organon of Medicine has submitted MBBS degree instead of BHMS.

B. Miscellaneous: Acquittance of 03 teachers not provided.

4. That the applicant has set up the Homoeopathic Medical College and teaching Hospital with the component of staff, infrastructure, equipment and instruments and other facilities where as the College has to take urgent and time bound steps to fulfill the above requirements for conducting Under Graduate course

Accordingly, it is to inform you that all the relevant documents submitted by your college in Part-I proforma were examined by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

B. Part Time Teacher:

- i. The College filled 08 teachers but not a single teacher eligible the consultant of modern medicine are same as eligible guest faculty.
3. After considering the provisions of section 12C (1) of Homoeopathy Central Council Act, 1973 and HCC(MSR) Regulations, 2013, permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board is issued to **Dr. G.D. Pol Foundations Yerala Homoeopathic Medical College and Research Centre Dr. G.D. 5. It may please also be noted that in case you do not attend the hearing at the stipulated time and date, it will be presumed that you have nothing to say and further necessary action in terms of the HCC Act, 1973 and the relevant regulations will be taken based on available records.

This has reference to this Department's letter of even number dated 26th August, 2013, wherein amnesty for non-enforcement of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 was granted for the academic year 2013-14 for all existing Homoeopathy Colleges. Accordingly, CCH was requested to inform all the existing Homoeopathy Medical Colleges and also direct the colleges to ensure compliance of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 and accordingly remove all the shortcomings as required for getting conditional permission for the subsequent academic session 2014-15 as per the provisions of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013.

In light of the visitations done by CCH from 1st January, 2014 onwards, the Central Government during preliminary discussions with CCH had come to the understanding that most of the Homoeopathy Medical Colleges are still not able to comply with the requisite norms as required under the HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 for obtaining conditional permission for the session 2014-15. Further, in absence of enabling provision in the HCC Act, 1973 for granting permissions on annual basis to the existing colleges, the amnesty for non-enforcement of HCC (MSR) Regulations, 2013 is being granted for the academic
